1 Price Comparison

Get quotes from at least three pharmacies (local, specialty, and online)

Ask about bulk purchase discounts or package deals

2 Discount & Assistance Programs

Ask clinic about manufacturer discount programs (Compassionate Care, First Steps, etc.)

Apply for income-based assistance if eligible

Check if your clinic participates in a shared cycle or unused medication return program

3 Coupons & Savings Cards

Search for GoodRx, Optum Perks, or pharmacy-specific coupons

Sign up for manufacturer and pharmacy email alerts for promotions

4 Prescription Strategies

Ask if prescriptions can be split into smaller fills to avoid waste

Confirm generic versions are available and appropriate

5 Special Access & Benefits

If military, check VA or military pharmacy pricing and eligibility

Use HSA/FSA funds to pay with pre-tax dollars

Save receipts for possible tax deductions

6 Communication

Involve your Care Team in every step to ensure safety and accuracy

Confirm medication storage and expiration dates before purchase
